Audrey Long Robinson of Silverhill, Alabama passed away April 6, 2019 at the age of 86. Born Jan 31, 1933 in Bay Minette, AL, Audrey spent the majority of her life in Baldwin County. A devout Christian and lifelong member of the Church of Christ, Audrey spent her life devoting her time to others. After helping raise donations and supplies, she went on eleven mission trips to South America, specifically the impoverished villages of Guyana, where she helped meet the physical and spiritual needs of villagers there. She loved to play. She was an avid tennis player, loved swimming in the pool with her Grandchildren, and was even known to pull the occasional practical joke.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Calvin and Lenora Long of Bay Minette and her brothers Aubrey Long, Billy Long, and Jack Long.

Audrey is survived by her husband of forty-three years, Jerry Robinson, her Brother Earl Ree Long, her three children, Michael Lee Priesgen (Charlene), Lynn Marie Priesgen Pepper (Fred), and Bobby Marcelle Robinson (Erica). She has eight amazing Grandchildren, four precious Great Grandchildren and many nieces and nephews, whom she absolutely adored.

A memorial service celebrating Audrey's homecoming will be held at Robertsdale Church of Christ, Thursday, April 11 at 3pm. We will enjoy coffee and desserts afterward.
