Hugh A. Wyatt, age 83, a Silverhill, AL, passed from this life to heaven on Thursday, May 23, 2013. He was born May 14, 1930 in Selma, AL as the youngest son to Walter & Rose Wyatt. He married the former Ola Jean Pope (deceased September 16, 2005) in 1950 and they raised their family in New Orleans, LA living there for 35 years.
